ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Participants must provide identification and be 18 years of age or over. Sound verbal and written comprehension of the English language is mandatory. Appropriate clothing and boots is required to be worn at each session.

PURPOSE:

Our three day training course is for people who have minimal or no backhoe operating experience. It's an intensive, hands-on training course, with the majority of the time spent operating the equipment. A strong theoretical component also focuses on safe operating procedures.

WHAT SKILLS WILL I GAIN?

OnRoad OffRoad Training has long a history with years of experience and an extensive fleet of mobile plant equipment. You will benefit from this training by understanding these five critical aspects to becoming a successful Backhoe driver/operator:

1. Pre Start Inspections
2. Cabin Controls and Dashboard orientation

5. Machine fundamentals, Safety & Emergencies

ASSESSMENT

Assessments will be conducted using formative assessments tools and a theory and practical assessment tool. The assessor will inform you of the assessments being conducted.

WHAT QUALIFICATION WILL I RECEIVE?

On successful completion of the course you will be awarded Statement of Attainment for RIIMPO319D - Conduct backhoe/loader operations. As part of the Australian Skills Quality Authority this program is nationally recognised.



TRAINING ON YOUR SITE?

Yes Training and assessment on your site can be conducted, but you must have access to the following

- Suitable area with a minimum of 2 different types of soils
- An Australian Standard Compliant Backhoe
- Attachments
- Suitable area to conduct the following mixing materials, stripping/spreading topsoils and materials, trench excavation, backfilling, lifting and carrying materials, loading dump trucks, wagons, hoppers, chutes, and cutting/boxing
- UHF radios-mobile phones
- Hand tools- shifter, hammer, shovel etc
- Log book- operators manual
- Transport truck and dump truck
- PPE-hard hat, vest, boots ,glasses ,ear plugs
- Lifting gear- slings, chains, hooks etc
- And a sufficient room to conduct class room activities/assessments (Classroom preferred)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payment of Fees/Refunds: What if you Cancel/Transfer, What if we Cancel/Transfer?

Payment of Fees

Fees are required to be paid prior to the commencement of courses. A deposit of 50% of the course fee is payable on enrolment and the balance prior to commencement of the course.

Our Cancellation/Transfer

Whilst we always endeavor to run scheduled courses we reserve the right to cancel or defer a course. In the event of this occurring, all fees will be refunded or you may elect to transfer to a course at a later date.

Your Cancellation/Transfer

If you are unable to attend a course, you may elect to re-schedule for that course, but only within 14 days of the original course date. We will not permit more than two (2) such transfers before a fee equivalent to 50% of the course fee will be charged.

If you cancel more than seven days prior to the course you may have any monies paid refunded in full or you may elect to be transferred to an alternative course with a fee adjustment.

If you cancel less than seven days prior to the course you will be charged a 50% (course fee) cancellation fee.

Should you not attend training/assessment a 100% cancellation fee, or loss of deposit, will apply.

Refunds

An application for refund must be made in writing (see F003-Refund Request Form) and will be determined by the Training Manager, or his delegate. Such supporting evidence (e.g. Doctor's Certificate / hardship) as is deemed appropriate should be provided with the written request.
