



## CPCCE3014A Remove non-friable asbestos

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### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

All participants must have a White Card (CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry) which is separately offered by OnRoad OffRoad Training. This is a required pre-requisite for these two units.

### **PURPOSE:**

This course covers an in depth understanding of the hazards, risks and risk control measures required for asbestos removal. Since the introduction of the WHS Act significant changes have occurred in the field of asbestos removal. Licenced asbestos removalists must possess these units of competency. The assessments will include various detailed assessments.

### **WHAT SKILLS WILL I GAIN?**

During the course you will acquire skills and knowledge in the following areas:

- Risk management of asbestos or ACM in the construction industry
- Training and licensing requirements for asbestos removal, identification and management
- The asbestos register and the asbestos management plan
- Asbestos hazards and risk management
- Appropriate legislative requirements and responsibilities
- Risk control measures relating to asbestos removal (e.g. specialised PPE), and
- Additional information and help concerning asbestos management.

### **ASSESSMENT**

Assessments will be conducted using theory and practical assessment tools, the practical assessment will be conducted in a realistic work environment. The assessor will inform you of the assessments being conducted

### **WHAT QUALIFICATION WILL I RECEIVE?**

Upon successful completion of the assessments for this course the participant will be awarded a Statement of Attainment for: CPCCE3014A Remove non-friable asbestos. Qualification will be issued through Get Safe Training PTY LTD, RTO number 31465.

### **Payment of Fees/Refunds: What if you Cancel/Transfer, What if we Cancel/Transfer?**

#### **Payment of Fees**

If you cancel less than seven days prior to the course you will be charged a 50% (course fee) cancellation fee.

Should you not attend training/assessment a 100% cancellation fee, or loss of deposit, will apply.

#### **Refunds**

An application for refund must be made in writing (see F003-Refund Request Form) and will be determined by the Training Manager, or his delegate. Such supporting evidence (e.g. Doctor's Certificate / hardship) as is deemed appropriate should be provided with the written request.
